- I. Welcome & Introductions Absent: Rody Boonchouy, Bruce Colby
- II. Review of Advisory Board Norms:
 - Maintain a clear agenda.
 - Thinking "Charter-wide." What's best for grades 7-12.
- III. General Updates:
 - <u>Safety Week</u>: Different drills throughout the week. Fire/evacuation, teacher down, shelter in place, i.e. fire across street or emergency responders on campus, then we need to keep path clear vs. lockdown, i.e. activity on campus, keep students on campus. Communication would be at teacher discretion.



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Outcomes:

*Students/staff did their job very well.

*Determined louder bells are needed.

*Advisory member asked if students were informed how to respond. Yes, students instructed, as well as instructed to turn off phones. Teachers to instruct students when to pull out phones.

*Next year, teachers to instruct students to turn phones off or at a minimum turn sound off.

*Active shooter Lockdown: Serious

*Shelter in place: Could be nearby danger. Get in safe place.

*Holding status drill: Most frequently used to keep students in classroom i.e. student with health concern so emergency responders can access room. Status is lifted once needs are met.

*There will be an unannounced drill during 2nd semester.

*At DVHS site, some contacts were missing on the Emergency contact list. *At DVJH will add a "dynamic" drill, not in a controlled setting i.e. passing period, students at recess.

- Website & Student Landing Page: Separate links for both junior high and high school site. Updated with new phone and teacher links. *Apply Now* link will become active during recruitment. Landing page displays announcements before logging into Echo.
- Launch of Restorative Practices Referral System: Restorative Practice link and shout-outs also featured. Restorative Practice flow chart will also be posted in all the classroom. Structures how we want to resolve conflicts throughout grades 7-12. Ms. Pickett (JH) and Mrs. Nelson (HS) will do the intake and start the restorative process.
- IV. Review of Comprehensive School Safety Plans
 - DVHS Safety Plan: Drills will be conducted during 2nd semester. A concern about student accountability in case students need to leave campus was brought up. Where do they call? What if they get lost? Text alert on School Messenger will become available in the near future.
 - DVJH Safety Plan.
 - Safety Recommendations will be reviewed by outside consultant.

• The Advisory committee voted unanimously to approve Comprehensive School Safety Plans for both DVJH and DVHS. Updates to occur when staff changes and/or due to new protocols.
